Fire Protection License Requirements

License is required for any person engaging in the business of selling, installing, maintaining or repairing fire detection and fire alarm devices and equipment. This includes, but is not limited to, wet and dry sprinkler systems, kitchen range hood suppression systems, foam systems, spray booths, clean agent systems and maintenance of fire extinguishers.

All applicable requirements of the Fire Department and the Washington State Fire Marshal's office must be met.

License fee must be submitted with application. Applications received without payment will not be processed. Once the application has been processed, the application will be reviewed by the appropriate departments in the City for approval. A regulatory license certificate will be mailed upon approval of the license. Please allow up to 10-15 business days to receive notification of approval.
